**Large Appliance Recycling Rules**

Put out up to 3 items

Must remove refrigerator doors

Residents that have CURBSIDE collection should place their bulk items at the curb by 6am on the Monday of their collection week. Residents that have ALLEY collection should place their bulk in the alley behind their home (be sure to keep bulk items away from refuse containers).
